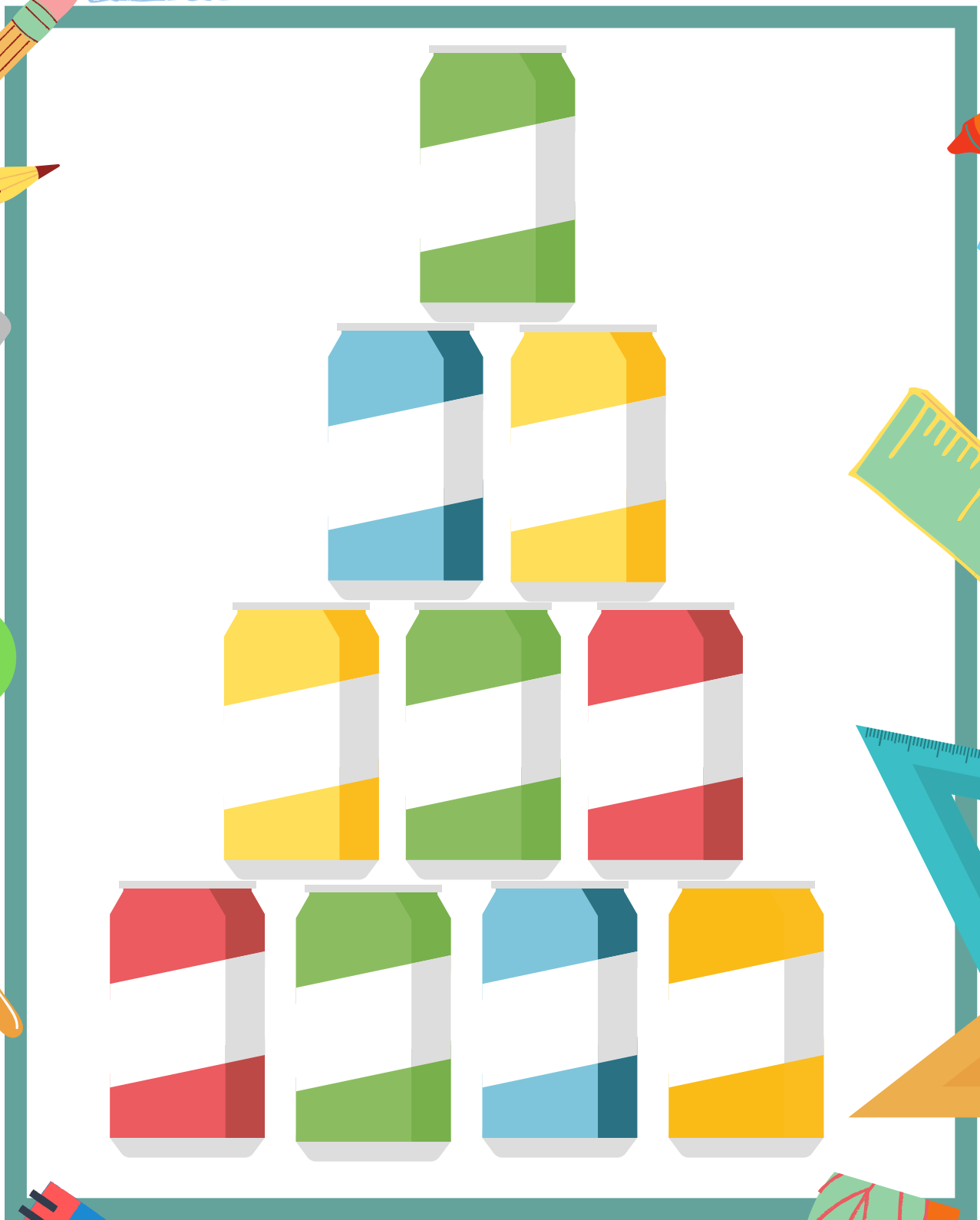

What You Will Need:

- Plastic Bottles - Approximately 6
- Coloured Paints
- Paint Brush
- Paper or Toilet Roll - To Make A Ball
(If you don't already have a ball in the house)
- Tape

Step By Step Guide:

1. Start by getting together 6 plastic bottles
2. You then want to paint your own design onto each bottle
3. Get creative, it's completely up to you!
4. Once they are dry, line them up with 3 starting at the back, then 2 in front and with 1 centred at the front
5. If you don't already have a ball in the house, scrunch some paper / toilet paper together and tape securely to create a ball
6. Make sure the tape is tight enough so the ball will knock over the pins
7. You're ready to bowl & score as many points as possible!
