GATOR BLOCK
Follow diagrams to make block


Hint: A "wedge" shape is etched into the lower corner of the template. When cutting the wedges, that etched marker should be on the wedge piece of your fabric to make sure you are cutting from the the correct side of the template. To ensure that your wedge angles are the same, always keep the bottom tip of the template on the edge of your fabric wedge.

flip template over \& repeat cutting on other side
use the double dot line trim for new wedge

flip template over \& repeat cutting on other side
use the triple dot line trim for new wedge

flip template over \& repeat cutting on other side
use 90 degree markings only to trim all 4 sides to square
finished block
