

1. Iron your batik fabric flat.
- 2 Cover the back side with fusible web - Leave the paper on.
3. Fold the fabric with the paper of the fusible web out fold in half then quarters then a few diagonal just like when you were a kid making a snowflake out of paper.
4. Use large heavy scissors to cut primarily straight lines to form shapes in your fused fabric.
5. Once pleased with the design open up remove the paper from the back of fabric and set on top of secondary fabric
6. Fuse the snowflake fabric to secondary fabric with hot iron. Follow the fusible web instructions for setting.
7. Basted quilt top to batting and backing and free motion machine quilt around all of the cutaway areas used contrasting threads for more interest.
