


THROUGH LOVE QUILT by Taren Studios

TIPS FOR USING PRECUT STRIPS



QUILT SIZE 64" X 78"

QUILT SUPPLIES

- 1 roll of 2½" ombré or print strips*
- 13/4 yards of white fabric
- 21/4 yards of black fabric
- 3/4 yard binding
- 4 yards backing horizontal seam(s), 5 yards backing - vertical seam(s), or 21/2 yards of 108" wide

*Note: We substituted 2½" ombré strips for the Fabric 1 yardage in the pattern.

- 1. Follow the instructions by Taren Studios to make your Through Love Quilt. We chose to substitute 1 roll of 2½" ombré strips in place of Fabric 1. If you choose to use precut 2½" strips, you will need 23 strips for this project. The remaining strips can be set aside for another project.
- 2. Choose the darkest and/or brightest colors from your roll of 2½" strips.
- 3. For ombré strips: Use the lightest parts of the strips for the 2 strips cut to 2½" x 9½" rectangles. These will be used to form the letter "E" and will help provide contrast with the background.
- 4. The strips that need to be cut 40½" can be folded in the center and trimmed 20¼" from the fold or sewn into the quilt and trimmed after the quilt top is complete.
- 5. Label each unit as you go for easy assembly when you complete the guilt top.
